### Phonics:

We will continue to work on unit 4 in foundations. The students will be putting together what they know about digraphs and bonus letters to make words like 'chill.' They will also be practicing building as many words as they can with bonus letters. We will also be reminding students when to use quotation marks around words. Students will be taking their unit 4 test on Friday.

### Reading:

We are wrapping up our unit on Elements of Fiction. We have covered characters, setting, and problem/solution. Next week we will begin learning about ABC order. We will practice alphabetizing based off of the first letter.

### Writing:

Next week the students will get to create a title page for their story. We will be stapling these cover pages along with a cover to the front of their books. There will be a few students reading their final stories to the class each day. We will store them in our own classroom libraries for all of our peers to enjoy! We will complete our Small Moment Writing Assessment on Thursday.

### Math:

Next week we will continue working on measuring and comparing objects by weight, area, capacity, temperature, and length. We will learn to use thermometers to determine the temperature. We will also work on identifying what the weather would be like and how to dress based on temperature. We have been improving our addition fact speed and accuracy by taking time tests. We have also been working on mastering our doubles facts this week.

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
